Matthew 26:36-46

Jesus' ministry began and ended with severe temptations. In Matthew 4, at the beginning of Christ's ministry, Satan tempted Him after He had fasted forty days in the wilderness with 3 waves of temptations. In like manner Jesus faces 3 waves of temptation in Matthew 26:36-46. Satan attacked Him at the beginning and end of His ministry, and Jesus was victorious on both occasions. Both temptations were personal and private solicitations to evil by Satan. In the first, Jesus answered each temptation with Scripture. Throughout the second, Jesus responded to each temptation with prayer. Jesus the Son of God is a Son in Sorrow.

THE RESTORATION OF A SINNING SAINT
