Today's Message: The Effect of Prevailing Prayer

Psalms 65:2

The Word of God assures us that God answers prayers of all flesh. Prayer is the means of fellowship with God. It is the link or connection between the creature and the creator, the needy and the supplier, the children and the Heavenly Father.

I. The Command to Pray

Matthew 7:7

Jesus does not limit asking from God to only a group or class of people. Anyone who seeks the Lord shall find Him (Isaiah 55:6). Christians need to pray without ceasing (I Thessalonians 5:17).

II. God's Promise to Answer Prayer

Luke 18:1 - 8

God's Word assures us that He answers prayer. Sometimes, He answers prayer instantly and sometimes later. Other times, God doesn't answer at all when we ask amiss (James 4:3).

III. Conditions of Successful Prayers
